Donor Bill of Rights

All donors and prospective donors to the CFUW Charitable Trust have the right to:

- Be informed of the CFUW Charitable Trust's mission, how the Trust intends to use their donations, and of its capacity to use them effectively for their intended purpose.
- Know who the trustees of the CFUW Charitable Trust are, and to expect that they will act responsibly and exercise prudent judgment.
- Have access to the CFUW Charitable Trust's most recent financial statements.
- Be assured that their gifts will be used for the purposes for which they were given.
- Receive appropriate acknowledgement and recognition.
- Receive professional and courteous treatment by CFUW CT representatives.
- Have their names or any information about them treated with the utmost confidentiality and neither shared nor sold on a donors mailing list.
- Be informed that all individuals seeking donations on behalf of the CFUW Charitable Trust are volunteers and not hired solicitors.
- Receive prompt, truthful and complete answers to any questions they have about contributions to the CFUW Charitable Trust.
